Abstract Items

1. Title
 - a. Clear Title, Concise, Precise, Reflect the content of the abstract
2. Authors name and affiliation
 - a. presenting author with *
3. Objective
 - a. Is the objective clearly defined?
 - b. What is the interest of the study in African Context/milieu?
4. Subject and Methodology
 - a. Clearly described, is it suitable to attain objective of the study, Sample Size, Statistical analysis well adapted
5. Results
 - a. General characteristics of the study population described, describe the principal results, are these findings well presented?
6. Conclusion and Interpretation
 - a. Is it clearly formulated and precise?
